Summary of key findings for parents

The provision meets requirements

- Through discussion, the manager and her deputy describe how they will help children to extend their communication skills. They talk about how they will use teaching strategies, such as using effective questioning, to enable children to build on their vocabulary.
- The manager and her deputy demonstrate how they will work with parents to support children's learning. They talk about the information they will acquire from them when children start attending the setting, to effectively plan activities that reflect children's stage of development.
- The manager describes how she will support children to settle into the nursery and develop relationships with her and the staff team. She talks about the settling-in procedures and how they are flexible based on the needs of individual children.
- The manager and her staff team have a good understanding of safeguarding procedures. They describe the signs that may indicate possible abuse and explain how they will report any concerns they may have about a child in their care.
- The manager and her deputy describe how they evaluate the quality of the nursery and will seek the views of parents to help them identify ways they can improve.

There were no children present when this inspection took place. The findings in this report are based on evidence gathered from discussions with those who care for the children and an inspection of the premises, equipment and relevant documentation. Where there are no children present, no judgement is made on the quality of the early years provision as there is no reliable evidence on which to assess its impact on children. The report states whether the provider continues to meet the requirements of registration.

Inspection activities

- The inspector had a tour of the premises.
- The inspector discussed with the manager and deputy their knowledge and understanding of the requirements of the early years foundation stage.
- The inspector discussed with the manager and her staff team their understanding of safeguarding procedures.
- The inspector checked the suitability of all staff working at the nursery.
- The inspector viewed a range of documents, such as policies and risk assessments.

Twinkle Toes Nursery registered in 1997. The nursery employs three members of childcare staff. All staff hold appropriate early years qualifications at level 3 or higher. The nursery opens from Monday to Friday all year round. Sessions are from 9am to 12pm. The nursery provides funded early education for two-, three- and four-year-old children.
