

Compliance action taken for childcare provision

Summary of outcome

All early years providers must meet the legal requirements in the 'Statutory framework for the early years foundation stage', which you can find at www.gov.uk/government/publications/early-years-foundation-stage-framework--2. If we find that a provider is not meeting the requirements, we can take action to ensure they put matters right.

On 23 January 2018, the provider notified us that a child sustained significant injuries, which may have happened while in the care of the provider. The notification means that the provider met their legal responsibility as set out in the early years foundation stage welfare requirements to notify Ofsted of any serious accident, illness or injury to, or death of, any child while in their care, and of the action taken.

It was found that the provider had breached a requirement relating to 'Safety and suitability of premises, environment and equipment'. However we are satisfied with the action they took to comply. Additionally, we have served two actions. This notice requires the provider to take the actions below within the timescales set out. The provider will be able to give parents further information about this. The provider is still registered with Ofsted.

Actions needed:

complete risk assessments to identify how any risks will be removed or minimised in respect of the security of the outdoor perimeter fencing and gates, and the water heater, which is accessible to children in their toilet and wash area (Risk assessment). To be completed by 19/03/2018.

ensure that the local child protection agency is notified of any serious accident or injury to any child, while in the care of the provider, and act on any advice from that agency (Accident or injury). To be completed by

19/03/2018.

A suitable response to the actions was received.

Publication of compliance action

We aim to ensure that the welfare of children and young people is protected in the services we regulate. The Childcare Act 2006 and accompanying regulations set out our responsibilities to regulate childminders and childcare providers. This includes the enforcement powers we have in relation to those registered providers who do not comply with the requirements for registration.

We publish details of any actions we take, or the childminder or childcare provider takes to bring about compliance with requirements on our website for a period of five years commencing on the date we complete our investigation.
